

- **1807** The U.S. Congress passed an act to "prohibit the importation of these into any port or place within the jurisdiction of the United States from any foreign kingdom, place, or country.
- **1887** He was declared the winner of the 1876 presidential election by the U.S. Congress. Samuel J. Tilden, however, had won the popular vote on November 7, 1876...
- 1897 He vetoed legislation that would have required a literacy test for immigrants entering the country.
- 1899 U.S. President McKinley signed a measure that created the rank of Admiral for the U.S. Navy. He was named the first admiral.
- 1903 The Martha Washington Hotel opened for business in New York City. The hotel had 416 rooms and was the first hotel exclusively for these.
- 1962 This Philadelphia center scores 100 points, most ever by an NBA player in a single game, in Warriors' 169-147 win over NY Knicks in Hershey; 36-of-63 from field, 28-of-32 from free-throw line
