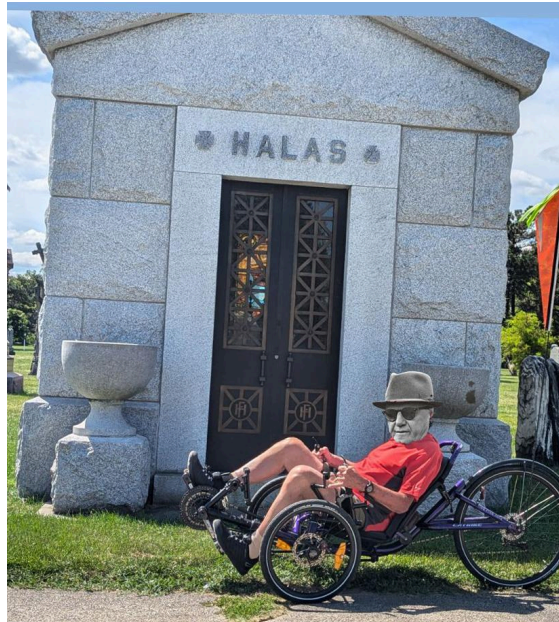

**1928** - IX Summer Olympic Games close in this European city..

**1936** - The gymnastics competition at the Berlin Olympics concludes with this country dominating, winning 6 of 9 gold medals including the men's & women's teams events

**1949** - 16th NFL Chicago All-Star Game: All-Stars lose 38-0 to this team before (93,780).

**1950** - First international game by an NFL team, they beat CFL's Ottawa Roughriders, 20-6 in Ottawa

**1969** - This team sold for an NBA record \$6 million
