**1620** - The "Mayflower", and its passengers, pilgrims from England, landed at this location

**1891** - First game of basketball, based on rules created by this man, was played by 18 students in Springfield, Massachusetts

**1937**- Walt Disney debuted the first, full-length, animated feature in Hollywood, CA. What was the movie?

**1941** - Chicago Bears Ray McLean makes last NFL extra point this way.

**1944** - This sport was banned in the United States until after the end of World War II.

**1945** - This U.S. Gen. dies in Heidelberg, Germany, of injuries from a car accident.

**1969** - This Washington Redskin coaches his last football game, a 20-10 loss to the Cowboys in Dallas, for a 7-5-2 season and 105-35-6 career

**1981** - Cincinnati defeats this Illinois school 75-73 in seven overtimes. The game was the longest collegiate basketball game in the history of NCAA Division I competition.

**1997** - He is 3rd NFL player to run for 2,000 yards in a season
