1923 - Baseball games canceled following the death of this US President

1933 - This watch was introduced for the 1st time with a price of \$2.75.

1936 - He wins the 1st of his 4 gold medals in the Berlin Olympics.

1941 - He goes 0-4 in loss v St. Louis Browns, ending his on-base streak of 74 games

1943 - Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower ordered him to apologize for slapping and abusing a private.

1948 - At age 42, this pitcher debuts in Cleveland, goes 7 innings in 5-3 win v Washington
