

- **1920** 52nd Belmont: Clarence Kummer aboard this horse wins by massive 20 lengths in world record 2:14.2
- **1928** New York Yankees future Baseball Hall of Famer collects 14 total bases with 2 triples and 2 home runs in a 15-7 win over Chicago White Sox
- **1938** This Reds pitched his second straight no-hitter.
- **1950** Following his retirement announcement after 49 years he is named Honorary Manager of the MLB All-Star Game
- **1957** He plays in his 823rd game (new NL consecutive-game streak)
- 1982 In the capital city of Stanley, this war ended as these troops surrendered to the British.
