1912 - Philadelphia Athletics rout Detroit Tigers, 24-2 at Shibe Park; Tigers use amateurs in protest over this players' suspension from the game

1917 - The U.S. Congress passed the Selective Service act, which called up soldiers to fight in this war.

1920 - 45th Preakness: Clarence Kummer aboard this horse (regarded as greatest racehorse of all time) defeats Upset by 1+1/2 lengths in 1:51.6

1956 - He hits HRs from both sides of plate for record 3rd time

1968- He hits his 307th HR, surpassing Hank Greenberg as a Tiger

1971 - 4th ABA Championship: Utah Stars beat this team, 4 games to 3

1971 - Stanley Cup Final: Henri Richard scores twice as Montreal Canadiens beat this team for a 4-3 series victory
