**1930** - His MLB errorless streak ends at 885 consecutive games

**1939** - During World War II, Germany and this country agreed upon a plan on the division of Poland.

**1941** - He ended the baseball season with .406 batting avg

**1951** - His 2nd no-hitter of 1951, an 8-0 home victory over Boston Red Sox; Yankees clinch pennant #18

**1952** - This HOF outfielder makes his only major league pitching appearance, throwing one pitch to Chicago Cubs Frank Baumholtz
