1788 - The U.S. Constitution went into effect when this state became the ninth to ratify it.

1932 - He loses his heavyweight boxing titles in controversial split points decision to American Jack Sharkey in NYC

1940 - Thelma Catherine Ryan marries this future US President

1946 - He buys MLB baseball team Cleveland Indians for \$2.2 million

1950 - He gets his 2,000th hit, a 7th-inning single, in a 8-2 victory over Cleveland

1954 - He ran the mile in 3:58. He was the second person to run under 4:00

1970 - FIFA World Cup Final, they become the 1st country to win the cup 3 times
